

**Psychonomic Society Travel Award
Instructions - 2024**



Award Premise: This award supports travel expenses by a graduate student member or post-doctoral member of the society with a \$300 prize, supported by the Psychonomic Society.

We strongly encourage applications from diverse peoples. The CCS seeks to address structural inequities in science which disproportionately burden specific groups that are represented by (but not limited to): Indigenous peoples, race, ethnicity, national origin, sex, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, socio-economic status, age, and religion.

Award Eligibility: Students must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- The applicant must be a CCS graduate student member or postdoctoral member at the time of application.
- The applicant must be presenting at the 2024 Conference on Comparative Cognition.

Award Application Process: Students and postdocs wishing to be considered for this award need to submit the following information:

- Name and email
- Stage in program (i.e., M.Sc., Ph.D., post-doc, and year in program)
- Endorsing supervisor name and email
- A long abstract for the presentation at CO3 (one-page including graph)
- A current CV
- A letter of endorsement from the student's supervisor that endorses the abstract and its contents, verifies that the applicant is in the stage of their program reported, is currently a graduate student or postdoc in good academic standing, and is in agreement that the student may be considered for the award
